

## Friday Masters Captain Responsibilities and Notes      2024 Season

1. Be at the courts for each game by 2:30 (courts are available at 2:00). Appoint someone on your team to be your assistant captain and notify them to take your place if you cannot make a game.
2. Maintain the schedule and review it before each to ensure the team you're playing and the court.
3. There is a sub list of players who do not want to play on a regular basis. If one or more of your team members informs you that they can't play for a given date, you can call them.
4. Early in the week send an email to your team members. Ask them to confirm they are attending, give them the court number, encourage them to come early and practice. Some captains like to make up line up along their email.
5. Remind your team members to bring a cap or visor. The sails from last season are gone and the sun can be in your eyes, especially on the east side of the courts. Sunscreen is also advisable. The umbrellas are not effective for either.
6. We will be playing 3 games starting at 3:00.
7. We play all 3 games to 10 points, unless the last game has not reached 10 points by 4:50. The team at that time will win the game.
8. Captains should also remind their teams to bring hats/visors and sunscreen as the new umbrellas are not as effective in shading the courts as the old sails were.
9. We will be playing three games each week to 10 points or 4:50pm, whichever comes first.
10. Teams have been determined, and Ben Bachrach will publish/distribute a package to all players with the team rosters, schedules, and rules.
11. The winning team captain will advise Ben at the end of the match the number of games one and loss.
12. Team standings will be tracked and published on the website as well as on the bulletin board located at the bocce courts.
13. Captains have been selected partly on their bocce play. Try to help newcomers on the basic play, rules, and throwing technique.
14. Leave the court with the balls on the rack, the courts sweep, paddles, and tape measures put away.
15. If there is a problem, question or dispute seek out one of the Master's Bocce committee members (Terry Mountford, Don Jancin, Lynelle Moscaritolo, Kay Howard, Brian Sherlock) for assistance.
